We are pleased to announce this call for applications for the 2020 CNAS Scholars Summer Research Fellows. This Research Fellows Program is a part of the Research in Science and Engineering (RISE) Program. RISE is a 10-week Summer research program designed to prepare participants for graduate and professional study by providing valuable research experiences, training, seminars and multiple workshops aimed at better preparing scientists.

If you are currently a part of the CNAS Scholars Learning Community (LC), and you wish to engage in research on campus this summer through RISE as a CNAS Summer Research Fellow, you should apply now.

Benefits of participating:

- Professional and personal development workshops and programs throughout the summer
- Guidance and mentorship through a research program from your choice of dynamic CNAS faculty
- Stipend Amount: \$5,000

If you are selected for one of these prestigious Summer Research Stipends, you will need to consider:

- Duration: Required hours of participation will be Monday-Friday from 8am-5pm, from June 22-Aug. 28, 2020 (*dates tentative*). Your time commitment will include actual hours spent in research and consultation with laboratory mentors as well as additional, required professional and personal development activities.
- Housing: On-Campus housing is <u>not</u> provided by CNAS although not required, it is available. If you
 do not already have summer housing arrangements, you can contact UCR Housing, Conference and
 Event Services at <u>housing.ucr.edu</u> for more information.
- 3) **Research:** Once you identify your faculty mentor, they will assist you in finding a research topic. Please make sure to include a Letter of Recommendation from the faculty member (who will mentor you through research this summer) in your application packet along with a proposal describing your agreed-upon research project.
- 4) Summer Session is not possible. Due to the schedule of the CNAS Summer Research Fellows Program, if you are chosen to become a Fellow you will not be able to enroll in Summer Sessions at the same time.
- 5) **Research information workshops** will take place in Pierce 2301 on the following dates and are each limited to the first 30 students to sign-up. Workshop attendance is <u>mandatory</u> to apply for the RISE program. To RSVP, complete sign-up at the link below.
